Regular markets, including Farmers' Market launched in High Street. Introduced Christmas



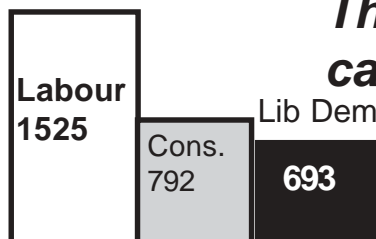
Ice Rink along with improved Christmas lights. Bargate opened and repairs to Tudor House secured.
